

### Operation School Bell®

- Operation School Bell is our primary philanthropic program.
- During the school year, our goal is to provide approximately 800 K-12 grade children in need with new school clothing.

All children are referred by school officials and receive from \$110-125 each to spend on clothing. This is done either through Operation School Bell clothing certificates or in-store shopping events held at the local Fred Meyer store.



## Other Programs

Other philanthropic programs throughout the year include:

- Providing schools and special reading programs with award-winning books.
- Supplying basic needs to sheltered families in abuse crisis situations.
- Painting U.S. maps on school playgrounds.
